We will meet at 5:30 p.m. for hors d'oeuvres and cocktails, at the house of David and Judith Bennahum, at 1707 Notre Dame NE, and then re-assemble for dinner at Vivace Restaurant, between 6:45-7:00 p.m. Directions to the Bennahum household are as follows: From the northwest corner of Indian School Rd. and Carlisle, go west two long blocks (along Ind. School), to Notre Dame Rd.

Turn right (northward) and it is not far, on the west side of the street..

The restaurant is rather near, at 3118 Central SE, a little more than 2 blocks East of Girard, on the south side. There is only onstreet parking, but the side streets should be fairly easy at that time. This venue is new, but looks quite nice. Upon arrival you will be provided with a special menu, printed for our event, from which you may choose an entree, and dessert, from a list that includes chicken, salmon, veal, shrimp with pasta, and a vegetarian pasta dish.
